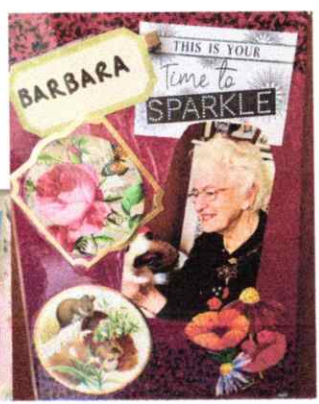
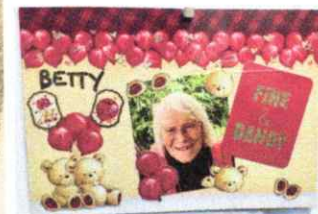
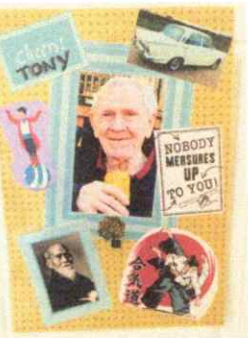
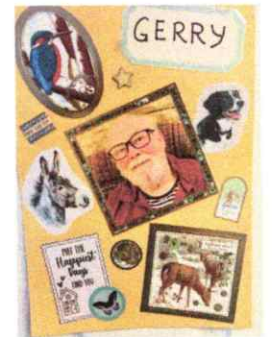


August 2023 Newsletter
