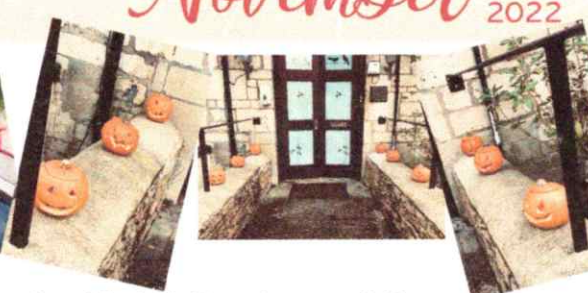




# November 2022
